She has consulted with children on a wide range of issues and developed particular knowledge and expertise in working with children and young people who present with sexually concerning behaviour.

Lorraine is trained as a non-registered Intermediary, providing communication support to children and young people in their involvement with the police and the courts. She is also a member of Triangle's multidisciplinary teams providing expert opinion to the family courts.
